Here's how to become a History Keeper

In two simple steps, you can make a lasting impact on the mission of TCHM.

1.	Arrange your estate to leave a gift to TCHM. Common ways to do this are:
	 As a beneficiary of a bequest through your Will or Trust As a beneficiary in an IRA or 401K Retirement Plan As a beneficiary or owner of a Life Insurance Policy As a beneciary of a Charitable Gift Annuity, Charitable Remainder Trust, or other planned gift
2.	Inform Tri-Cities Historical Museum that you have made the necessary arrangements by returning this form. This will give us permission to include your name in future listings of our legacy donor group, the <i>History Keepers</i> .
